### **Australian Passports – Adult Applicants**

This information sheet should be read in conjunction with the guidance notes available at [www.passports.gov.au](http://www.passports.gov.au).

From 4 July 2018, applications or renewals of an Australian passport will be accepted by appointment only, Monday to Friday between 8:30am and 12:00pm (subject to appointment availability and excluding [Embassy public holidays](#)). All passport applications must be lodged in person.

Your new passport will take **3 weeks (15 working days)** to process. If you need to travel while your new document is being processed, please advise staff at the interview. For this option you will need to keep your current passport and present it to us for cancellation when you collect your new passport. If you choose to have your current passport cancelled at the interview, your new passport can be mailed to you in Thailand or collected in person from the Consular Services Section at the Embassy.

*To replace an existing undamaged Australian adult passport*

**Full Application - Overseas Passport Application (PC8)**  
**First Australian Passport or to replace a lost, stolen or damaged Passport**

Before your passport interview appointment:

- Please register and log-on via [www.passports.gov.au](http://www.passports.gov.au) to complete the Application Form

Please bring the following **original documents** and **one photocopy of each** to the passport interview appointment:

- Completed Application Form including a properly completed Guarantor section (see attached list of guarantor categories)
- Most recent Australian passport (if applicable)
- If born in Australia - original Australian birth certificate
- If born in Australia on or after 20/08/1986 - Original Australian birth certificate **plus** evidence to prove your Australian citizenship or to prove that one of your parents was an Australian citizen at the time of your birth

- If born overseas – original birth certificate AND original translation stamped by the translation office AND original Australian Citizenship certificate
- Three supporting IDs in your full name such as Australian or foreign driving licence, foreign passport, Australian Proof of Age card, Medicare card, debit/credit card, health care card. *At least one of these must show your photo and residential address.*

- If your Australian passport has been lost or stolen you must also present a Thai police report

**Passport pages full?**

We can offer a **replacement passport** if your passport **still has at least two years validity remaining**. The replacement passport will have the same expiry date as the original passport. *(Note: this option replaces the former Frequent Traveller 64 page passports)*

## Fees

Adults are issued with a (34 page) 10 year validity passport.

- The fee for this passport is AUD282 plus overseas surcharge AUD105 - total AUD387.

Where visa pages are full, adults may choose a 34 page replacement passport which will have the same expiry date as their existing passport.

- The fee for this passport is: AUD178 (no overseas surcharge).

Adults aged 75 years and older may request a 5 year validity passport.

- The fee for this passport is AUD142 plus overseas surcharge AUD105 - total AUD247.

Fees are payable in **Thai Baht** by **CREDIT or DEBIT CARD** and are linked to the AUD/THB exchange rate and re-aligned monthly. For current THB fee information please contact the Consular Services Section or e-mail: [consular.bangkok@dfat.gov.au](mailto:consular.bangkok@dfat.gov.au)

- or
