

From 7 January 2019

The Australian Embassy Thailand and Consulate General Phuket will **NOT** be witnessing **statutory declarations which declare income or bank balances** for Thai Immigration purposes.

Why?

Thai Immigration wants us to verify your income or bank balance and we are unable to do this.

What do I do now?

You should show the Thai Authorities that you have the income required to obtain your visa by transferring the funds needed into a Thai bank account.

What do I need for my Thai visa application?

Retirement Visa Requirements

- You must be at least 50 years old; and
- Demonstrate you have sufficient funds in a Thai bank account (minimum of THB 800,000 for at least 3 months before applying) or an average monthly income (no less than THB 65,000 over a 12 month period).

Marriage Visa Requirements

- You must be legally married to a Thai national; and
- Your Thai bank account must show a minimum of THB 400,000 for at least 2 months before you apply for your visa; or you must have an average monthly income of no less than THB 40,000.
